CENTRAL QUEENSLAND TO HOST MAJOR ONSITE AUCTION

Local and Interstate buyers are expected to snap up several million dollars-worth of second hand equipment at Hassalls' on-site auction in Dysart on Wednesday 14 September from 10am.
